

Habilitando HTTPS no APACHE CentOS 7

- Instalar módulo do SSL para o Apache

```
yum install mod_ssl
```

- Adiciona no início do arquivo do VirtualHost o redirecionador de HTTP para HTTPS

```
<VirtualHost *:80>
    ServerName gugainfo.com.br
    ServerAlias www.gugainfo.com.br
    Redirect / https://gugainfo.com.br
</VirtualHost>
```

- Configura o Virtualhost com a porta 443, habilita o SSL Engine e adiciona caminhos para os certificados

```
<VirtualHost *:443>
    ServerName gugainfo.com.br
    ServerAlias gugainfo.com.br
    DocumentRoot "/var/www/dokuwiki"
    SSL Engine On
    SSLCertificateFile /etc/ssl/certs/gugainfo.com.br.crt
    SSLCertificateKeyFile /etc/ssl/certs/gugainfo.com.br.key #Private Key
    SSLCACertificateFile /etc/ssl/certs/gugainfo.com.br.root.crt #Root CA
</VirtualHost>
```

- Reiniciar o serviço do apache para concluir

```
systemctl restart httpd
```
